The Utah Department of Health, Division of Medicaid and Health Financing, formally requests to withdraw the pending amendment request to add a Family Planning Services program to the Utah 1115 Primary Care Network (PCN) Demonstration Waiver. The State submitted this request on June 29, 2018. The State is no longer in need of this waiver amendment due to the approval and implementation of the Adult Expansion Population on April 1, 2019. Individuals who would have been eligible under the Family Planning Services waiver amendment are now eligible for Adult Expansion, which covers all family planning services included in the waiver amendment.
