Your seventh title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State plan amendment (SPA) submitted on August 18, 2010, with revised State plan pages and additional information submitted on October 13, 2010, has been approved. This amendment has a retroactive effective date of October 1, 2010.

Section 10203 of the Affordable Care Act amends the definition of a targeted low-income child in section 2110(b)(2)(B) of the Social Security Act (the Act) by permitting States to cover children of State employees under CHIP if the State has maintained its contribution levels for employees with dependent coverage since 1997, or can demonstrate that the State employees' health benefits plan's out-of-pocket costs pose a financial hardship for the family. This new coverage option was effective upon enactment of the Affordable Care Act on March 23, 2010.

This SPA permits Montana to provide CHIP coverage under Healthy Montana Kids (HMK) to children of State employees and Montana University System employees with an income level at or below 250 percent of the Federal poverty level (FPL) through the financial hardship exception under the Affordable Care Act.
