RE: AMENDMENT TO HAWAII MEDICAID STATE PLAN

Pursuant to Section 5006(e)(2) of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the Department of Human Services, Med-QUEST Division (MQD) is soliciting your expedited consultation on the proposed amendment to the Hawaii Medicaid State Plan.

The amendment proposes to ease the transition for young adults leaving foster homes through the extension of Medicaid coverage for former foster children who have aged out of foster care who are under age 26 years old; have household income up to 300 percent of the federal poverty level; were enrolled in Medicaid; and are not eligible or enrolled under existing Medicaid eligibility groups.
