With the exception of the waiver of section 1916(f), which permitted the state the ability to require a graduated co-payment up to \$25 for non-emergency use of the emergency department, the current list of waivers, expenditure authorities, and special terms and conditions will continue to apply to the demonstration until February 28, 2018.
