Thank you for providing an update and supplement to the state's extension request for Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) 1.0, which was submitted on June 30, 2014. As indicated in our July 15, 2014 response, the state's extension request previously did not include an interim evaluation report or meet the requirements for tribal consultation, which were required prior to submission to The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). We have completed a preliminary review of the extension request, including supplemental material received October 18, 2014, and have determined that the state's extension request has met the requirements for a complete request as specified under section 42 CFR 431.412(c).

In accordance with section 42 CFR 431.416(a), CMS acknowledges receipt of the state's extension request. The documents will be posted on Medicaid.gov and the comment period will last 30 days, as required under 42 CFR 431.416(b).
