This letter is to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is approving an extension of a temporary freeze in enrollment previously authorized in our July 23, 2014 letter for the Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) 1115 demonstration. Approval of the amendment to this demonstration is under the authority of section 1115(a) of the Social Security Act and is effective from the date of this letter through December 31, 2014.

This extension of the enrollment freeze into the HIP demonstration for parents and childless adults is due to the state's continued budgetary constraints for this demonstration. The state will continue to take administrative action so that parents and childless adults who apply for HIP on or after the date of this letter through December 31, 2014 are placed on a waiting list to allow for transition and enrollment of these individuals, should other coverage options become available. We look forward to continuing to work with you and your staff as the state works to expand Medicaid to the new low-income adult eligibility group through HIP 2.0.

The authorities provided in this demonstration award are subject to CMS receiving your written acknowledgement of this approval within 30 days of the date of this letter. The state's existing approved Special Terms and Conditions (STCs), waivers and expenditure authorities for the demonstration in all other respects remain unchanged, and in effect.
