I am writing to provide an update and supplement to the waiver application we previously submitted to you on February 13, 2013, referenced as the Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) waiver renewal request 2014-2016.

As you may recall from the phone conversation we had a few weeks ago, I explained that we had submitted the application prior to conducting public hearings in order to provide you and your team additional time to review it. The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) held two public hearings on March 20 and March 22, 2013. The process complied fully with the final federal 1115 waiver submission rules. A summary of the stakeholder feedback is included as an attachment to this letter and shall serve as a supplement to our waiver application.

Many stakeholders testified in support of HIP's consumer-driven model which has been offered to enrollees over the past five years.
