Thank you for your recent request to extend the state's Gateway to Better Health section 1115 demonstration (Project No. 11-W-00250/7). The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received your initial three-year extension request on December 26, 2012, followed by your two-year extension request on March 28, 2014. At that time, we completed a preliminary review of the application and determined that the state's extension request had met the requirements for a complete extension request as specified under section 42 CFR 431.412(c). The documents were posted on Medicaid.gov and the comment period lasted 30 days, as required under 42 CFR 431.416(b).
