Introduction

The purpose of the 1115 (a) Waiver for Family Planning services is to allow Mississippi Medicaid to improve the provision of family planning services to a population of women who otherwise may be unable to access the services, with the expectation that decreasing unintended pregnancies, increasing the child spacing interval, and referring for continuance of care will improve future birth outcomes thereby leading to net savings for the Mississippi Medicaid program.

The State Department of Health (SDH) staff maintains their efforts to increase education by conducting and/or participating in educational presentations, health fairs and wellness clinics. These efforts target non-family planning users who benefit from the message of family planning and reproductive health. Media campaigns were carried across statewide television, internet and Public Service Announcements (PSA).

Operational Updates

Quarter 2

- For the Federal Fiscal Quarter 01-01-14 through 03-31-14, the Family Planning Review Nurse conducted 40 medical reviews and 60 technical support visits. Eighty-one (81) referrals noted for outside resources. Eleven (11) providers were required to submit action plans.
