Dear Dr. Dzielak:

With this letter, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is granting a temporary extension of Mississippi's Family Planning Demonstration (Project No. 11-W-00157/4) until June 30, 2014. The demonstration is currently operating under the authority of section 1115(a) of the Social Security Act. The current lists of waiver and expenditure authorities and special terms and conditions will continue to apply to the Mississippi Family Planning Demonstration until June 30, 2014.

As you know, starting January 1, 2014, eligibility for Medicaid for most individuals will be determined using methodologies that are based on modified adjusted gross income (MAGI). This requirement applies to eligibility for family planning section 1115 demonstrations. In addition, starting October 1, 2013, states are also required to make available a single, streamlined application for MAGI-based eligibility.

We understand that there are special attributes of this demonstration to consider when deciding how to integrate family planning eligibility into the state's MAGI eligibility rules and the single, streamlined application process. Should you need additional time to integrate these features into your family planning section 1115 demonstration, CMS requests that you use the standard process of requesting acceptable mitigations. Your project officer, Shanna Wiley, with the Division of State Demonstrations and Waivers, is available to work with you to determine the appropriate approach for your state if you are not able to integrate these features into your family planning 1115 demonstration by January 1, 2014.
