<p>Provide a means for end users to report server errors on your system.</p>	<p>The cms.gov web site has no facility to report server errors. This makes it impossible for I.T. professionals to contact CMS to report server failures on your web site.</p> <p>Providing a link to report web site issues is a standard industry practice dating back to the original adoption of the World Wide Web. It's something every, and any, commercial, educational, or government entity does. Except, apparently, CMS.gov.</p> <p>For example--at the time of this writing, any HTTP request to https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov is throwing a 500 error. Which means your server has crashed. This has been blocking any provider from attempting to register for an NPI number; which in turn prevents them from registering with their state MA funding source; which keeps them from providing services to clients with mental disabilities.</p> <p>How can we tell CMS to tell Ernie to go restart the server (or, hey, just bounce the Application Pool)? At present, there does not appear to be a way.</p> <p>The smart way would be for CMS.gov to provide that facility.
