

**PENNSYLVANIA'S FAMILY PLANNING DEMONSTRATION WAIVER PROJECT**  
**PROJECT NUMBER 11-W- 00233/3**  
**APRIL, MAY AND JUNE 2015 QUARTERLY REPORT**

**General Program Overview:**

Pennsylvania's Family Planning 1115 Demonstration Waiver, referred to as SelectPlan for Women, was implemented on February 1, 2008. The waiver provides family planning services for a woman who:

- is between the ages of 18 and 44
- is a resident of Pennsylvania
- is a U.S. citizen or has satisfactory immigration status
- has income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- is not otherwise eligible for Medicaid
- has no other insurance coverage for family planning services
- is not pregnant or sterilized

**Eligibility:**

There were no eligibility policy changes in the second quarter of 2015. The caseload is approximately 68,976 beneficiaries.

**Evaluation/Primary Care Referral:**

During the second quarter for calendar year 2015 (4/1/2015-6/30/2015), the Bureau continued to track SelectPlan for Women program data.

**Provider Education/Claims Processes:**

During this quarter, 35,047 claims\* were processed for SelectPlan for Women professional, outpatient and pharmaceutical services. As of June 30, 2015, there were 5,616,929 total claims processed for these services since the program's inception on February 1, 2008.

Number of Beneficiaries with Paid Services Adjudicated in the Quarter: 7,036

\* The number includes paid, denied and adjusted claims with the remittance advice date in the quarter. The number of claims dropped from 85,211 in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2015. This decrease is attributed to the migration of beneficiaries into other categories of assistance and status codes (i.e. Healthcare Benefit Packages).

\*\* The number includes any beneficiary who was ever eligible during the quarter, for at least one day.

**Future Changes:**

Since June 1, 2012, the State has been operating the Family Planning 1115 Demonstration Waiver under temporary extensions with the standing terms and conditions. On June 17, 2015, CMS granted the State's request to extend the waiver until December 31, 2015, to ensure continued coverage as the State transitions to the Family Planning State Plan option. SelectPlan beneficiaries were given a Non-Continuous Eligibility segment (NCE) to extend their coverage through December 31, 2015, at which time the SelectPlan Waiver will expire. Effective July 1, 2015, the State will begin enrolling beneficiaries in the Family Planning State Plan option to receive their family planning services. All beneficiaries enrolled in SelectPlan will be transitioned to the Family Planning State Plan option by December 31, 2015.
