Thank you for the state's communication regarding an extension of Pennsylvania's Medicaid section 1115 family planning demonstration. The state requested that the current program, which is due to expire on March 31, 2013, be extended to June 30, 2013.

With this letter, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is granting a temporary extension of Pennsylvania's family planning demonstration until June 30, 2013. The demonstration is currently operating under the authority of section 1115(a) of the Social Security Act.
