Dear Mr. Greenfield:

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) submitted for CMS' consideration Texas 1115 Demonstration Amendment 10, Year 2 Carryover, on December 1, 2014.

Amendment 10 proposed the following:

To utilize unallocated DSRIP funds from DY2 to build on existing, approved DSRIP projects in DY5 by increasing project capacity (more Medicaid/low income uninsured individuals served and encounters provided), increasing data exchange, and improving project-specific evaluation, with an effective date of April 1, 2015.

Recent correspondence with CMS indicated that this amendment is no longer relevant to the 1115 demonstration.
