
Dear Administrator Verma:

I am pleased to accept CMS's November 25, 2019 approval of Utah Medicaid's request to amend its 1115 Primary Care Network (PCN) Demonstration (Project Nos. 11-W-00145/8 and 21-W-00054/8). This approval allows Utah to provide "intensive stabilization services (ISS)" for Medicaid eligible children and youth under age 21 who are either in state custody or at risk of being placed in state custody, and who are experiencing significant emotional and/or behavioral challenges. This approval will allow the State to provide important crisis and stabilization services that will allow the child to remain in the family's home.
