Dear Secretary Smith:

In accordance with Vermont's Global Commitment to Health section 1115(a) demonstration Special Terms and Conditions (STCs), the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has completed its review of the new investment notification and has determined that the investment meets the requirements specified in Attachment I: "Menu of Approvable Delivery System Investments." Therefore, we are updating the investment list in Attachment H to include the additional Delivery System investment. The update in the list of investments does not modify the previously granted expenditure authority for these investments and CMS is not changing the cap on annual investments as stipulated in STC 84 (Demonstration Year 4: \$136.5 million (total computable)).

The investment titled, OneCare Vermont Accountable Care Organization (ACO) Expanded Advanced Community Care Coordination Care Team Training, Technical Assistance, and Expansion of the Developmental Understanding and Legal Collaboration for Everyone (DULCE) Pilot, meets the requirements of the delivery system related investment Category #1(b)(4) "Advanced Community Care Coordination Projects" because the investment assists the ACO in expanding upon current programs to enhance the delivery of care, in addition to offering beneficiaries improved management of their chronic conditions. The state confirmed this investment is strictly administrative in nature. Therefore, the state will claim this investment at the 50 percent administrative matching rate. The state expects this investment will cost \$1,567,083 million (total computable) for Calendar Year 2020.
