**C. QUALIFIED MEDICARE BENEFICIARIES WITH INCOMES RELATED TO
FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINE**

The levels for determining income eligibility for groups of qualified Medicare beneficiaries under the provisions of section 1905(p)(2)(A) of the Act are as follows:

1. NON-SECTION 1902(f) STATES

a. Based on the following percent of the official Federal income poverty level:

Eff. Jan 1, 1989: ____ 85 percent ____ ____ percent (no more than 100)

Eff. Jan 1, 1990: ____ 90 percent ____ ____ percent (no more than 100)

Eff. Jan 1, 1991: 100 percent

Eff. Jan 1, 1992: 100 percent

b. Levels

The level for determining income eligibility for the Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries under section 1905 (p)(2)(A) and 1905(p)(4) of the Act is 100% of the official Federal poverty level guideline for Alaska for the family size, as revised annually in the Federal Register.
