The Department intends to modify Attachments 3.1A and 3.1B of the Connecticut Medicaid State Plan in order to eliminate coverage of chiropractic services for clients under age twenty-one. This change is expected to result in estimated federal savings of \$32,000 in FFY13 and \$35,000 in FFY14. As required by 42 U.S.C. §§ 1396d(a)(4)(B) and 1396d(r)(5), clients under age twenty-one may still receive chiropractic services as EPSDT special services if their provider submits proper documentation that such services are "necessaryto correct or ameliorate defects and physical and mental illnesses and conditions discovered by the screening services." 42 U.S.C. § 1396d(r)(5).
