On November 22, 2011, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received lowa's State Plan Amendment (SPA), transmittal #11-026 through which the State is assuring compliance with Section 4107 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Affordable Care Act), P.L. 111-148, in providing tobacco cessation services for pregnant women.

Smoking cessation drug coverage was approved for pregnant women consistent with the Public Health Services guidelines on February 8, 2012 in SPA #11-025.

SPA #11-026 was approved on July 18, 2012, with an effective date of October 1, 2011, as requested by the State. This approval provides coverage for face-to-face tobacco cessation counseling services for pregnant women. This approval brings lowa into total compliance with section 4107.

Enclosed is a copy of the CMS 179 form and the approved pages for incorporation into the Iowa Medicaid State plan.

As discussed with your staff it will be necessary for lowa to submit a separate State Plan Amendment to comply with section 2301 of the Affordable Care Act, freestanding birthing center services and provide evidence of public notice in accordance with 42 CFR 445. 205 at the time of the submittal.
