On July 20, 2012, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received lowa's State Plan Amendment (SPA), transmittal # 12-010, to update the State's vaccine reimbursement page to reflect current vaccine administration payment information. Under this SPA, providers receiving a fee-scheduled reimbursement will receive an increase from \$5.00 to \$5.30 for percutaneous, intradermal, or jet injections. Additionally, these providers will now receive reimbursement of \$13.43 per vaccine administered orally or intranasal. Providers receiving cost-based reimbursement (critical access hospitals) will remain cost-based

Based on the information provided, this SPA is approved as of October 5, 2012, with an effective date of July 1, 2012, as requested by the State. Enclosed is a copy of the CMS 179 form, as well as, the approved pages for incorporation into the Iowa State Plan.
