RE: Idaho State Plan Amendment (SPA) Transmittal Number 11-012

Dear Mr. Armstrong:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Seattle Regional Office has completed its review of State Plan Amendment (SPA) Transmittal Number 11-012. This SPA changes coverage for adult beneficiaries by: (1) reducing chiropractic coverage from 24 visits per year to six visits per year; (2) limiting podiatry and vision coverage to chronic care situations; and (3) eliminating the audiology benefit. This SPA does not impact the coverage of these services for children.

During the review of Idaho SPA 11-012, CMS determined that multiple program and financial related pages (not directly related to the SPA request under review) require updating and/or revision to correctly describe the current operation of the State's Basic and Enhanced Benchmark Programs, or to comply with current CMS policy. Under separate cover, CMS will release a letter detailing those issues and provide guidance on timeframes for corrections.

This SPA is approved effective July 3, 2011, as requested by the State.
