

(c) Notwithstanding all other provisions of this rule, all initial interim Medicaid rates established on or after the effective date of this rule through the end of the first calendar quarter following the effective date of this rule shall be reduced by the following amounts, and shall remain reduced for the entire interim rate period:

(d) Per diem Medicaid rates paid to nonstate owned intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded (ICFs/MR) and community residential facilities for the developmentally disabled (CRFs/DD) are subject to a 3% rate reduction effective April 1, 2010. The 3% rate reduction will remain in effect through June 30, 2011.
