

13. FY-2009 trend adjustment —

A. Facilities with either an interim rate or a prospective rate in effect on July 1, 2008, shall be granted an increase to their per diem rate effective for dates of service beginning July 1, 2008, of six dollars and zero cents (\$6.00) to allow for a trend adjustment to ensure quality nursing facility services.

B. The trend adjustment shall be added to the facility's reimbursement rate as of June 30, 2008 and is effective for dates of service beginning July 1, 2008 and after.

Effective July 1, 2009, this amendment provides for a per diem increase of \$5.50 for nursing facility and HIV nursing facility services. The increase is funded in part by an increase in the State's NF provider tax of \$0.65 per patient occupancy day.
