We have reviewed the proposed amendment to Attachment 4.19-A of your Medicaid State plan submitted under transmittal number (TN) 11-22. This amendment reduces inpatient hospital service payment rates by 2.5 percent. This amendment also modifies the medical education payment methodology to allow for annual updates so that payments more closely reflect hospital case mix changes.

We conducted our review of your submittal according to the statutory requirements at sections 1902(a)(13), 1902(a)(30), 1903(a) and 1923 of the Social Security Act and the implementing Federal regulations at 42 CFR 447 Subpart C. This is to inform you that Medicaid State plan amendment 11-22 is approved effective July 1, 2011. We are enclosing the HCFA-179 and the amended plan pages.
