## ADDITIONAL CLASS OF DISPROPORTIONATE SHARE PAYMENTS TO CERTAIN DSH HOSPITALS

The Department will make an additional class of disproportionate share hospital (DSH) payments to certain qualifying acute care general hospitals. This payment is intended to promote the availability of professional medical services to the MA population in less urbanized areas of the Commonwealth.

To qualify for these payments, a hospital must meet all the following criteria. Unless otherwise stated, the source of the information is the State Fiscal Year 2010-2011 MA cost report (MA-336).

- The hospital is enrolled in Pennsylvania's (PA) MA Program as an acute care general hospital.
- The hospital is located in a county of the third class with a population between 279,000 and 282,000 under the 2010 federal decennial census.
- 3) The hospital's PA MA Fee-for-Service Medical Education costs exceed \$500,000.

Payments to qualifying hospitals will be divided equally among all qualifying hospitals. All payment limitations are still applicable, including those limitations that the Commonwealth may not exceed its aggregate annual DSH allotment, and that no hospital may receive DSH payments in excess of its hospital-specific limit.

For Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-2014, the fiscal impact as a result of this additional class of disproportionate share hospital payments is \$1.076 million (\$0.500 million in State General Funds and \$0.576 million in Federal Funds upon approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services).
