Dear State Medicaid Director Lipman:

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) issues this corrective action plan (CAP) completion letter to New Hampshire as an acknowledgment of the state's commitment to address compliance with the home and community-based services (HCBS) settings regulations found at a 42 CFR §441.301(c)(4)-(5). The state's settings CAP impacted the following 1915(c) HCBS waiver programs:

- Developmental Disabilities (DD)-NH.0053
- Acquired Brain Disorder (ABD)-NH.4177
- Choices For Independence (CFI)-NH.0060

CMS has determined that New Hampshire meets all requirements related to the development and implementation of the settings CAP. CMS recognizes the state's assurance and CAP activities, which consisted of monthly meetings with CMS, completed milestones and timelines, transparency and access to information associated with the components of the CAP, stakeholder engagement and modifications to state administrative rules. CMS will continue to provide technical assistance as needed to the state regarding the required federal waiver assurances.
