This letter is regarding Nevada's corrective action plan (CAP) to address Site-Specific Remediation and Validation Activities, and Statewide Compliance with the federal home and community-based services (HCBS) regulations found at 42 CFR §441.301(c)(4) and (5). These issues affected Highland Manor, an assisted living facility in Fallon, Nevada and Opportunity Village, a Jobs and Day Training (JDT) and Supported Employment site in Las Vegas, Nevada.
