<sup>a</sup> For some measures, the measurement period for the numerator, denominator, or continuous enrollment period varies depending on a specified date for each enrollee (such as enrollee birthdates, prescription or treatment start dates, and discharge dates). For these measures, two ranges are shown. The first date range identifies the full range of possible dates that states will need to use to calculate the measure for all measure-eligible enrollees. The text in parentheses describes the measurement period that should be used for each eligible enrollee.

<sup>b</sup> When reporting each measure to CMS, states should report the measurement period they used for the denominator in the “Start Date” and “End Date” fields. For many measures, this date range corresponds to calendar year 2016 (January 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016). Some measures also require states to review utilization or enrollment prior to this period to identify the measure eligible population. For these measures, two date ranges are included in this table. The first date range should be used to populate the Start Date and End Date fields, while the second date range defines these prior review periods and should not be included in

the Start Date and End Date fields. For example, FFY 2017 specifications for the MMA-CH measure instruct states to identify enrollees with asthma controller medication prescriptions that started during the calendar year 2016 denominator period (the first date range). However, states will also need to review eligibility and utilization data from calendar year 2015 to identify enrollees with persistent asthma (the second date range). States that followed FFY 2017 Child Core Set specifications should enter “January 2016” in the Start Date field and “December 2016” in the End Date field. States should note any deviations to any measurement period (numerator, denominator, continuous enrollment) in the “Deviations from Measurement Specifications” section.

<sup>f</sup> For some vaccines (e.g., DTap, HiB, IPV, Pneumococcal Conjugate, and Rotavirus) vaccinations that occur fewer than 42 days after birth should not be counted in the numerator. For the Influenza vaccine, vaccinations that occur fewer than 180 days after birth should not be counted in the numerator.
