## 2020 Core Set of Behavioral Health Measures for Medicaid and CHIP (Behavioral Health Core Set)

To support CMS's efforts to improve behavioral health in Medicaid and CHIP, CMS identified a core set of 18 behavioral health measures for voluntary reporting by state Medicaid and CHIP agencies. This Core Set, which consists of 5 measures from the Child Core Set and 13 measures from the Adult Core Set, will be used by CMS to measure and evaluate progress toward improvement.
