This letter is to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is in receipt of Colorado's application to extend its section 1115 demonstration, entitled "Colorado Adult Prenatal Coverage and Premium Assistance CHP+" (Project Number 21-W-00014/8). We are approving a six-month temporary extension of the state's section 1115 demonstration in order to allow time for CMS to work with the state to assess the state's application for consideration of an approval to extend the demonstration. This demonstration is now set to expire on December 31, 2020.

CMS is providing this temporary extension period conditioned upon the state's continued compliance with the Special Terms and Conditions (STCs) defining the nature, character, and extent of anticipated federal involvement in the demonstration project. The current STCs and expenditure authorities will continue to apply during the temporary extension of this demonstration until December 31, 2020.
