The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received Florida's request to amend its section 1115(a) demonstration titled "Florida Medicaid Family Planning" (Project Number 11-W-00135/4) on September 3, 2021. With this amendment request, the state seeks to extend the window of eligibility for the demonstration from 60-days postpartum to 12-months postpartum and to allow women who have a sterilization procedure to remain in the demonstration.

After completing a preliminary review of your amendment application, CMS has determined that Florida's application meets the requirements of STC #6.
