The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received Florida's request to amend its section 1115(a) demonstration titled "Managed Medical Assistance" (MMA) (Project Number 11-W-00206/4) on September 3, 2021. Florida is requesting several changes with this amendment request, such as seeking to modify the Low-Income Pool to include non-profit licensed behavioral health providers, extend the postpartum coverage period from 60-days to 12-months, and other changes to the Special Terms and Conditions (STC).

After completing a preliminary review of your amendment application, CMS has determined that Florida's application meets the requirements of STC #7.
