

Iowa Wellness Plan 1115 Demonstration Waiver Fourth Quarter 2020 and Annual Report

March 2021

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Iowa Wellness Plan (IWP) demonstration waiver began a new five-year waiver extension on January 1, 2020.

The biggest impact to the IWP for calendar year 2020 was the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE), starting in the middle of March and continuing throughout 2020. The PHE changed how the IWP operated. Iowa waived all contributions for the program and as a result, Healthy Behaviors were waived. Since no contributions were required, this decreased the number of appeals for contributions to zero. The Dental Wellness Plan (DWP) also waived contributions so all DWP members continued on full benefits for their enrollment period.

Although contributions were waived, some members continued to send in their contributions by either check or automatic withdrawal from their bank or credit union. In September, lowa sent refunds to those IWP and DWP members who had a credit balance.

Maintenance of effort was in effect during the PHE, which allowed members to continue their coverage throughout this time after their enrollment period. There was a 15 percent increase in enrollment in IWP during 2020 due to new members and not disenrolling members because of the maintenance of effort.

Following this letter is a detailed report of key activities and related statistics for the fourth quarter of 2020, consistent with the Special Terms and Conditions (STCs). SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR

Communications and Outreach

The PHE increased communication to IWP and DWP members. Early in the PHE, letters were sent to members informing them of the waiver of contributions, and no disenrollments, for the length of the PHE. Iowa developed a website with frequently asked questions about COVID-19 and how their health services were affected.

Telehealth services were quickly implemented during the PHE to ensure members could still receive any needed health services. In Iowa, dentists were unable to see members for dental visits, due to COVID-19 and Governor's restrictions, until the middle of May.

Communication to IWP members included the following:

- Updating the webpage for Medicaid and IWP members. This page included information on COVID-19, resources and some frequently asked questions. This webpage can be found at: https://dhs.iowa.gov/ime/members/COVID19.
- Electronic newsletters. IWP members, who have signed up to receive newsletters from the Department, received regular updates related to program changes and expanded services due to the COVID-19 PHE. These newsletters can be found at: https://dhs.iowa.gov/ime/about/IMENewsletters
- Member Services, the call center for members, was available to answer any COVID-19 questions in addition to the general questions the call center receives daily.

Ongoing communication includes:

Monthly Member Mailings:

- IA Health Link Member Welcome Packet: This packet is mailed to all new IWP members and includes information about IWP benefits, Healthy Behaviors and the Managed Care Organization (MCO) selection process.
- Healthy Behaviors Reminder Letters: These are sent from the member's MCO and reminds members they need to complete their Healthy Behaviors to keep their free health coverage. These letters have put on hold during the PHE.
- IWP Contribution Statements: These statements are sent to members who are required to pay monthly contributions. (These statements were put on hold in March 2020 as DHS suspended contributions during the PHE).

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Provider Outreach

On October 8, 2020, the public post award forum was held during the quarterly Medicaid Assistance Advisory Committee. The Committee consists of providers and stakeholders. The meeting is open to the public. The 2019 annual report was presented to those attending. There were no comments shared during the meeting. (See Attachment 1)

Legislative Developments

There were no legislative developments for IWP during calendar year 2020.

ELIGIBILITY/ENROLLMENT

Quarter Enrollment

The IWP population totaled 209,121 at the end of the fourth quarter of calendar year 2020. Month-end totals by population group are shown below.

Special Population Groups

The state monitors specific population groups enrolled in the IWP to ensure their health care needs are met in accordance with the STCs. These groups are comprised of: (1) Nineteen and twenty year-olds, (2) American Indian/Alaskan Natives, and (3) the medically exempt (frail). Annual Enrollment

The graph below compares the 2020 annual enrollment with the 2019 annual enrollment. The graph shows a 15 percent increase from 2019. The enrollment increase in 2020 corresponds to the beginning of the PHE in March 2020. This increase is due to new members coming on the program as well as members not being disenrolled from IWP.



ACCESS/DELIVERY

Effective April 1, 2016, the majority of Medicaid members began accessing services through the IA Health Link managed care program. 
MEMBER GRIEVANCES AND APPEALS

During this quarter, staff continued to participate in the Lifelong Smiles Coalition and coalition committees; Dental Wellness Plan information was shared with participants at the virtual lowa Community Health Conference. Regularly scheduled meetings with IDPH's I-Smile and I-Smile Silver Coordinators continued to allow for additional collaboration with populations being served. DDIA staff also began monthly meetings with lowa Total Care's community relations and outreach team to share community events, resources, and future projects. Through direct outreach and education to members, approximately 15,000 texts and more than 24,000 postcards have been sent to members this quarter for healthy behaviors completion, as well as the newly eligible and utilization populations. Last quarter, packages were sent to a portion of DWP diabetic members about the importance of oral health care and diabetes management. Calls were made to these members this quarter to answer questions and help those without a dental home find one. The DWP Customer Service Representatives continue to assist members in care coordination on a daily basis by calling new DWP members, and by taking inquiries through the Member Services phone line and email account.

During SFY Q2, MCNA was excited for the opportunity to again participate in the lowa Primary Care Association Annual Conference, virtually. MCNA has been focused on engaging members during this difficult year. It is more important than ever to encourage our members to see their providers and maintain their oral health. For the quarter we have deployed 15,797 text messages to members who had not had a dental visit within the last six months. We are now starting to see the impact of those text messages, 1,610 (10%) members had a dental visit within 60 days and 739 (5%) members received a preventive service.

Public Health Emergency (PHE)

The PHE continued during the fourth quarter 2020. Iowa continued to waive contributions and did not disenroll members. In September, Iowa issued refunds to IWP and DWP members who continued to pay their contributions during the PHE. This will allow members to have their money during the PHE without accruing a large credit balance.

Performance Metrics

lowa continues to work with CMS to develop the new performance metrics required for the 1115 waiver. These measures will touch all the requirements in the 1115 waiver that was approved starting January 1, 2020. The format of this report will change and more information on enrollment, health measures, healthy behaviors, contributions and retroactivity of eligibility will be included.



Covers adults ages 19-64 with income between 0 and 133 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)






