On December 18, 2024, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) approved a temporary extension and amendment of Indiana's section 1115 demonstration, titled "Workforce Bridge Account Program" (Project Number #11-W-00237/5), formerly "End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)" to allow Indiana and CMS to continue negotiations of the demonstration. This demonstration is set to expire on December 31, 2025.

The State of Indiana is allowing this waiver to expire as we focus our efforts on improving our existing health care programs to meet the goals of the President Trump and Governor Braun administrations.

As part of the original approval, the State of Indiana Family and Social Services Administration was required to submit a final report to CMS to describe the impact of this demonstration including, but not limited to, the impact on affected individuals. This letter is to notify CMS that the State of Indiana Family and Social Services Administration did not implement the 1115 demonstration, titled "Workforce Bridge Account Program" (Project Number #11-W-00237/5). Therefore, there was no impact.

We appreciate the partnership with CMS in designing and implementing programs for Hoosiers.
