Dear Commissioner Lisa Lee:

This letter is to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has approved a temporary extension of the state's section 1115 demonstration, entitled "TEAMKY" (Project Number 11-W-00306/4 and 21-W-00067/4), to continue negotiations with the state's September 30, 2022 extension application submitted. This demonstration will now expire on December 31, 2024.

CMS's approval is conditioned upon the state's continued compliance with the special terms and conditions (STCs) defining the nature, character, and extent of anticipated federal involvement in the project. The current STCs and expenditure authorities will continue to apply during the temporary extension period of this demonstration. The state's current budget neutrality agreement and per member per month amounts as of Demonstration Year 10 will continue to apply as described in the STCs, until December 31, 2024, or until the demonstration is extended, whichever is sooner.

For the temporary extension period, the state must continue to monitor its demonstration as stipulated in the current STCs. In addition, the state is required to include the temporary extension period in its demonstration evaluation. The state may choose to include the temporary extension period within its summative evaluation for the demonstration approval period beginning January 12, 2018. In this case, the Summative Evaluation Report is due 18 months after the end of the temporary extension period. Alternatively, if CMS approves an extension beyond December 31, 2024, the state may choose to include the temporary extension period in the Evaluation Design and activities of the next full demonstration approval period.
