The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received Michigan's request to extend the state's section 1115 demonstration entitled, "Flint Michigan Section 1115 Demonstration" on December 17, 2025. We have completed a preliminary review of your request and have determined that the state's application is complete in accordance with section 42 CFR 431.412(a).

Additionally, Michigan requested a "fast track" federal review process for their demonstration extension application, as outlined in the July 24, 2015, Center for Medicaid and CHIP Services (CMCS) Informational Bulletin<sup>1</sup>. CMS continues to evaluate if the Flint Michigan Section 1115 Demonstration application meets the criteria for a "fast track" federal review process.

Michigan's application will be posted on Medicaid.gov for a 30-day federal comment period as required by 42 CFR 431.416(b). The state's application will be available at:
