MO HealthNet would like to request a technical correction to the Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' (CMS), Special Terms and Condition #17 (STC) of the Section 1115 demonstration, project number 11-W-00343/7, known as the "Missouri Targeted Benefits for Postpartum Women" program. Mo HealthNet would like to add: 24. Limited Pharmacy Benefit to treat substance use disorders and related mental health conditions.

MO HealthNet included the cost of the pharmacy benefit in the budget neutrality and during our discussions with CMCS. It was an oversight that it was not included under STC section #17.
