Nevada's application will be posted on Medicaid.gov for a 30-day federal comment period as required by 42 CFR 431.416(b). The states application will be available at:

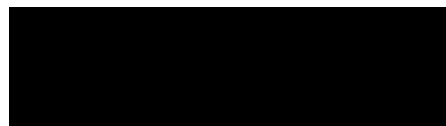
