Thank you for your request to amend New York's section 1115(a) demonstration, titled "Medicaid Redesign Team" (MRT) (Project Number 11-W-00114/2). The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received the state's proposal on March 25, 2021 to implement a 30-month transfer of assets lookback period for coverage of community-based long-term care (CBLTC) services—and to exclude certain enrollees from these proposed rules. We have completed a preliminary review of your request in accordance with the requirements of Section III, Special Term and Condition (STC) #7 and have determined that the state's application meets the requirements for a complete amendment application.
