Thank you for your request to amend New York's section 1115(a) demonstration, titled "Medicaid Redesign Team" (MRT) (Project Number 11-W-00114212). The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received New York's request on September 2, 2020. We have completed a preliminary review of your request in accordance with Special Term and Condition (STC) #7 and have determined that the state's application meets the requirements for a complete application.

In light of the national public health emergency concerning COVID-19 and statewide social distancing guidance to prevent its spread, several webinars for providers and beneficiaries were conducted in June 2020 to solicit feedback on the state's proposal. These webinars were permissible through CMS' authority under 42 CFR 431.416(g)(2) which allows a state to depart from normal public notice procedures due to the unforeseen nature of the public health emergency. Under section 431.416(g)(3), in order for a state to receive an exemption under section 431.416(g)(2), the state must meet three criteria: (i) the state must be acting in good faith, and in a diligent, timely, and prudent manner; (ii) the circumstances must constitute an emergency that could not have been reasonably foreseen; and (iii) it must be the case that a delay would undermine or compromise the purpose of the demonstration and be contrary to the interests of beneficiaries. CMS has determined that the state has met these criteria.

New York's amendment application will be posted on Medicaid.gov and the comment period will last 30 days in accordance with 42 CFR 431.416(b). The state's application will be available at: https://www.medicaid.gov/medicaid/section-1115-demo/demonstration-and-waiver-list/waivers faceted.html.
