The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received Texas's request to amend its section 1115(a) demonstration, entitled "Texas Healthcare Transformation and Quality Improvement Program" (THTQIP) (Project Number: 11-W-00278/6) on May 25, 2022. The state is requesting to provide an additional four months of Medicaid eligibility to women receiving Medicaid at the time they deliver or experience an involuntary miscarriage, for a total of six months of postpartum coverage. We have completed our preliminary review of your request and have determined that the state's application meets the requirements for a complete amendment application as specified under special term and condition #7.
