On May 18, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received Utah's request to amend the state's section 1115 demonstration entitled, "Medicaid Reform 1115 Demonstration" (formerly, "Primary Care Network") (Project Nos. 11-W-00145/8 and 21-W-00054/8), to provide twelve months of extended Medicaid coverage for certain postpartum women.
