On July 27, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) received Utah's three requests to amend the state's section 1115 demonstration entitled, "Medicaid Reform 1115 Demonstration" (Project Nos. 11-W-00145/8 and 21-W-00054/8), to separately provide family planning services, expand coverage for dental services, and provide support services for beneficiaries with a qualifying chronic condition.

We have completed a preliminary review of your amendment requests in accordance with the Special Terms and Conditions (STCs) and have determined that the state's amendment requests have met the requirements for a complete amendment as specified under STC 3.7.
