We have reviewed the proposed amendment to add section 7.4.A., Rescissions to the State's Disaster Relief Policies for the COVID-19 National Emergency, to the Arkansas Medicaid state plan as submitted under transmittal number (TN) AR-22-9912. This amendment proposes to rescind temporary policies in section 7.4., Medicaid Disaster Relief for the National Emergency.

Found in Disaster SPA 21-0012**

Effective January 7, 2023, the agency rescinds all elections found in Section 7.4 of SPA Number 21-0012 (approved on March 16, 2022) temporarily increasing the payment COVID-19 vaccine administration for doses 1 and 2 to respond to the changing needs of the State of Arkansas considering the continued COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.
