Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics and Supplies (DMEPOS) Maintenance and Repair Methods and Standards for Establishing Payment Rates

Effective January 1, 2023, DMEPOS maintenance and repair services are paid fee schedule rates at 65% of the Medicare fee schedule.

Effective April 1, 2025, DMEPOS maintenance and repair services are paid fee schedule rates at 80% of the Medicare fee schedule.

Effective October 1, 2025, annual preventive maintenance, up to one hour per year, will be allowed for DMEPOS equipment and devices that are no longer under manufacturer warranty. No prior authorization is required.

Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state-developed fee schedule rates are the same for both governmental and private providers of DMEPOS maintenance and repair services. The agency's fee schedule rate was set as of October 1, 2025 and is effective for services provided on or after that date.
