We have reviewed the proposed Michigan State Plan Amendment (SPA) to Attachment 4.19-B MI-25-0005, which was submitted to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025. ### Policy and Methods for Establishing Payment Rates (Other than Inpatient Hospital and Long Term Care Facilities)

#### 24a.1. Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT)

Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state-developed fee schedule rates are the same for both governmental and private providers of NEMT services. The Agency's fee schedule rates were originally set August 1,2018.

Effective May, 1, 2025, NEMT mileage reimbursement aligns with the IRS Standard Business rate. All rates are published on the Agency's website at www.michigan.gov/medicaidproviders.

For all other NEMT reimbursement, the current fee schedule is located at <u>www.michigan.gov/medicaidproviders</u> and is effective for services provided on or after October 1, 2018.
