## Pharmacy and Pharmacist Reimbursement

Reimbursement for services is made on a fee-for-service basis. The maximum allowable fee for a unit of service has been determined by MO Health Net to be a reasonable fee, consistent with efficiency, economy, and quality of care. The state payment for each service will be the lower of:

- 1. The provider's actual billed charge, or;
- 2. The allowable fee based on reasonable charge as determined above.

Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state developed fee schedule rates are the same for both public and private providers. The agency's fee schedule is published at https://dss.mo.gov/mhd/providers/pages/cptagree.htm and is effective for services provided on or after January 1, 2021.
