We have reviewed the proposed amendment to Attachment 4.19-D of your Medicaid State plan submitted under transmittal number (TN) 21-0020. This Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) provides for a per diem increase to nursing facility and HIV nursing facility per diem reimbursement rates of ten dollars and eighteen cents (\$10.18) effective for dates of service July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. This per diem increase provides an adjustment to nursing facility per diem rates for increases in costs associated with staffing, supplies, social distancing standards, and other factors due to the COVID-19 national emergency. Medicaid Disaster relief (DR) SPA 21-0021 was previously submitted to CMS as a priority COVID-19 initiative for expedited review and approval and will be terminated at the end of the National Public Health Emergency. Therefore, SPA 21-0020 is being submitted covering the same material as DR SPA 21-0021.

We conducted our review of your submittal according to the statutory requirements at sections 1902(a)(2), 1902(a)(13), 1902(a)(30), and 1903(a) of the Social Security Act and the implementing Federal regulations at 42 CFR 447 Subpart C.
