Telehealth store and forward technology involves the asynchronous, secure electronic transmission of a patient's health information in the form of patient-specific digital images and/or pre-recorded videos from a provider at an originating site to a consulting provider at a distant site without the patient present. Reimbursement for telehealth store and forward services is to be provided for Medicaid patients with conditions or clinical circumstances where the provision of telehealth services can appropriately reduce the need for on-site or in-office visits.

Effective on or after April 1, 2023, store and forward technology will include interprofessional consultations. The purpose of providing interprofessional consultations via telehealth is to assist the originating site provider in the management of patients whose medical needs are outside of the originating provider's expertise and/or scope of practice.

Reimbursement will be made to the consulting distant-site practitioner and the originating-site practitioner. Telehealth store and forward technology is reimbursed at 100% of the applicable fee for the evaluation and management or interprofessional consultation code that applies.

Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state-developed fee schedule rates are the same for both governmental and private providers of store and forward visits. The agency's fee schedule rate was last updated on December 22, 2022 and is effective for services provided on or after that date. Fee schedules are updated in January and April annually, and periodically during the year for time-sensitive changes (ex. COVID-19 codes).
