The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has reviewed the proposed New York state plan amendment (SPA) to Attachment 4.19-D NY 24-0063, which was submitted to CMS on September 25, 2024. This plan amendment proposes to provide a one time across the board funding increase of up to \$280.5 million to Nursing Homes.

1905(a)(4)(A) Nursing Facility Services

For the period beginning July 1, 2024 and ending March 31, 2025, a one-time across-the-board (ATB) increase will be provided to Article 28 nursing homes, increasing overall Medicaid reimbursement by up to \$280.5 million.

- a. Programs to receive funding as a part of this increase include:
 - i. Nursing Homes
 - ii. Specialty care facilities
- b. In order to fully distribute the available funding, one-time lump sum payments will be made to each facility. The lump sum payment per facility will be calculated as follows:
 - i. Divide the available amount of the ATB increase by the total of all facility Medicaid patient days for the most recent reported calendar year (2022). This will result in an ATB increase per Medicaid patient day.
 - ii. Then, take the ATB increase per patient day and multiply it by each facility's Medicaid patient days.
- c. The payments will be made as soon as possible upon approval from CMS and the NYS Division of the Budget.
